Italian Wine Laws

DOC

Introduced in the 1960s, it was the first PDO designation in common with French Appellation Controlee. It specifies the geographical area, permits grape varieties and minimum alcohol level. It may also stipulate the production method, including minimum ageing.

DOCG

DOCG wine must meet all DOC requirements, must be bottled in the region of production and is subject to a Ministry of Agriculture tasting. Each bottle will carry a numbered seal of approval.

IGT

IGT was introduced in 1992 equivalent to the French Vin de Pays. IGT regulation permits more freedom in terms of both area and grape and are therefore more prevalent in the south. IGT rules also permit grapes to be sourced from a larger area, a key factor when creating brands.

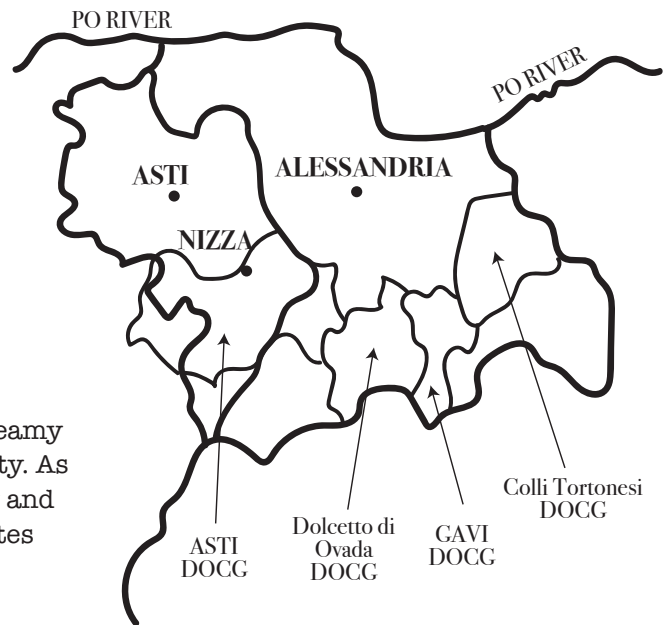

Gavi

Gavi, one of the first Italian white wines to gain an international reputation. It is more formally known as Cortese di Gavi because it is made exclusively from the Cortese grape. Gavi is the region, which is in the Province of Alessandria. Gavi wines are crisp, refreshing, and so bone dry that they will leave your mouth tingling.

Timorasso boast alluring floral scents, creamy apricot and apple flavors and bright acidity. As they age, they gain in mineral complexity and boast dried fruit, almond and honeyed notes seamlessly balanced with fresh acidity.



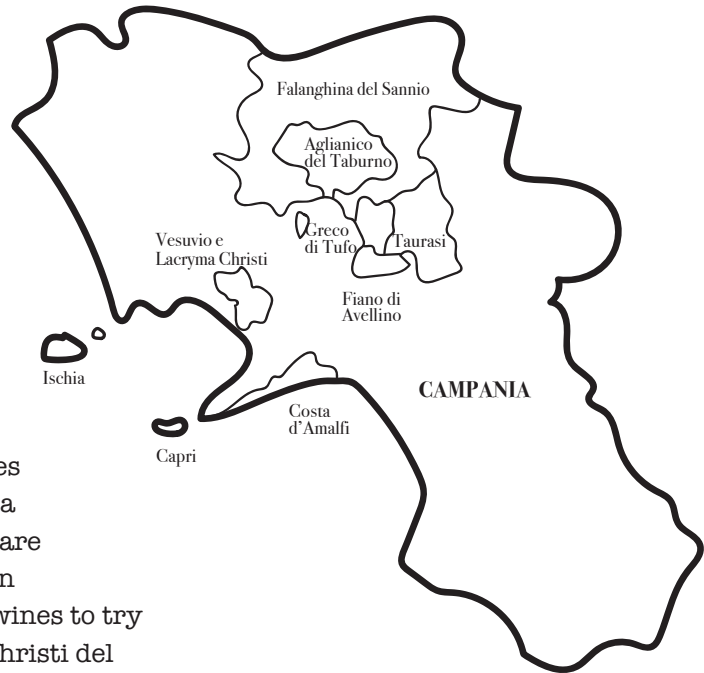

From the rolling hillsides in the provinces of Benevento and Avellino to the steeply terraced vineyards of the Amalfi Coast and the islands of Capri and Ischia to the slopes of Mt. Vesuvius, the wines of Campania are as varied as the landscape. There are many excellent regional wines made in Campania, but five classic Campania wines to try are Aglianico, Falanghina, Lacryma Christi del Vesuvio, Piedrosso and Greco di Tufo.

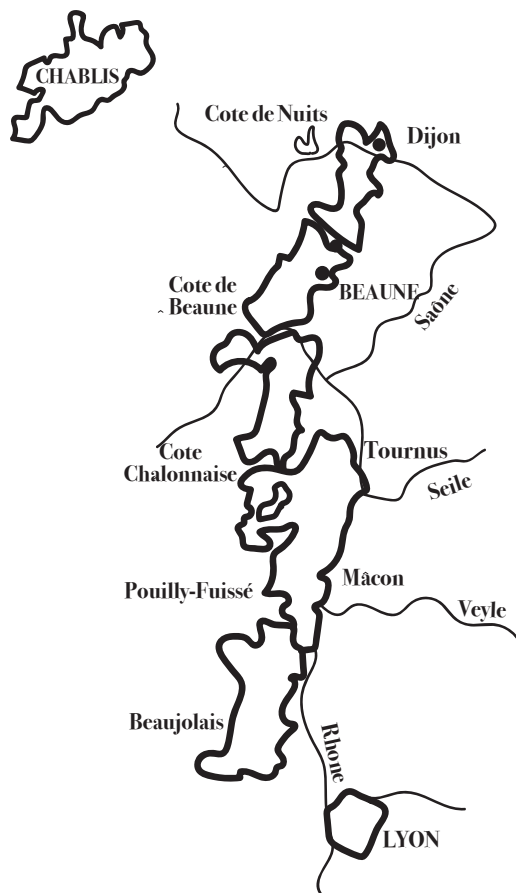

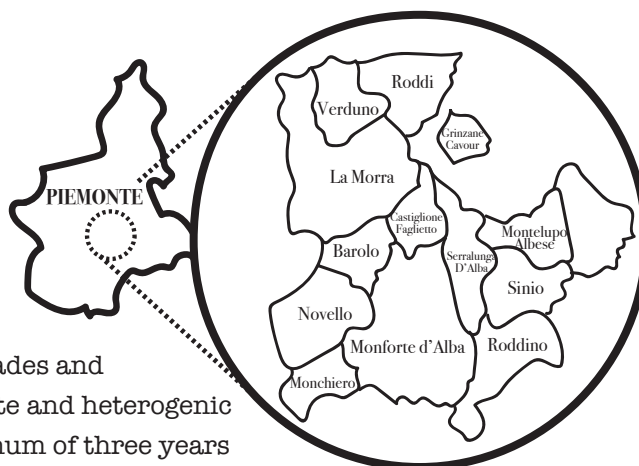
Barolo

The King of Wine and the Wine of Kings.

Barolo is based on Nebbiolo, a famous vine type used for other top regional wines like Barbaresco and Gattinara.

Barolo does not necessarily indicate a specific definition: the Barolo region in fact includes over 181 distinct

geographic producers, which means you have the chance to taste and discover shades and tastes derived from a varied micro-climate and heterogenic soil composition. Barolo requires a minimum of three years ageing and it best performs no earlier than 10 years. Like any star, Barolo knows how to tease a crowd.

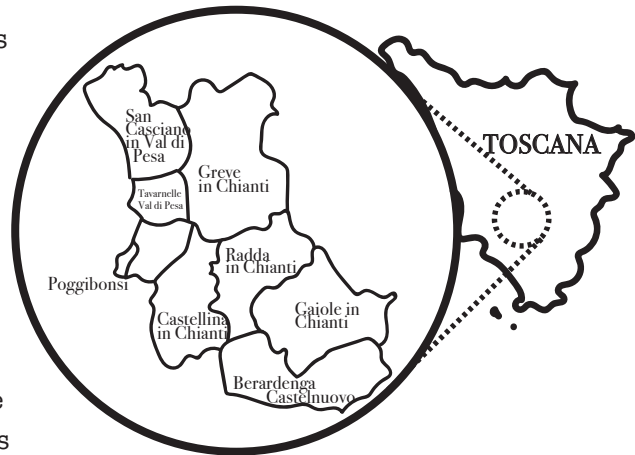

Chianti

In addition to splendid landscapes, Chianti's popularity is also directly tied to its fine red wines produced in the region and known generally as Chianti wine. The Chianti region, extending roughly over the two main city provinces of Florence and Siena, is characterised by a combination of almost perfect weather and soil that produces a precious wine considered one of the best wines around the world. The tradition of cultivating vines in Chianti goes back a long time in history, back to the Etruscans that inhabited the area before the Roman empire. The grape of excellence is Sangiovese and for a Chianti to bear the word Chianti on the label, not only must it be produced in the Chianti region, but it must also contain at least 80% Sangiovese grapes.

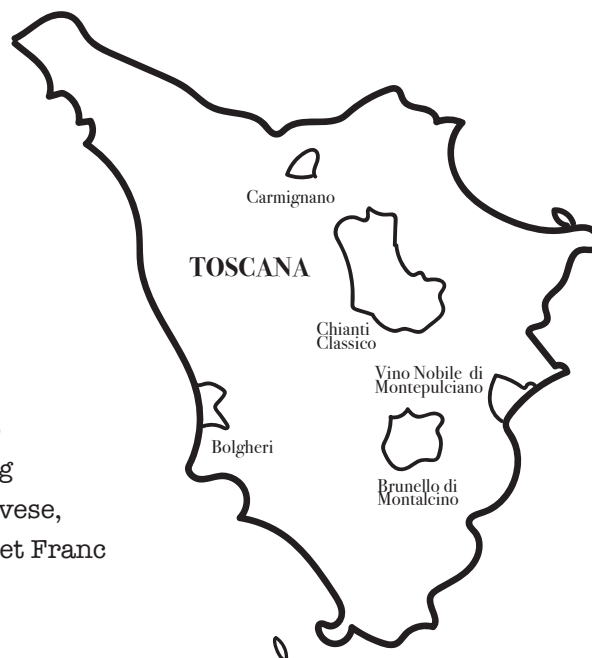

Bolgheri

Tuscan Wines of Bolgheri take their place in the sun. Bolgheri is a relatively young, yet prestigious Italian Appellation located in the Maremma on the Tuscan coast just to the south of Livorno and named after a town in the north of the region. It is known mainly for deeply coloured, supple yet age worthy red wines, usually based on the Bordeaux grape varieties. The winemaking zone features sloping coastal vineyards close to the Tyrrhenian Sea. Wines developed by making unique blends of different grape such us Sangiovese, Syrah, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc drop under the Super Tuscan category

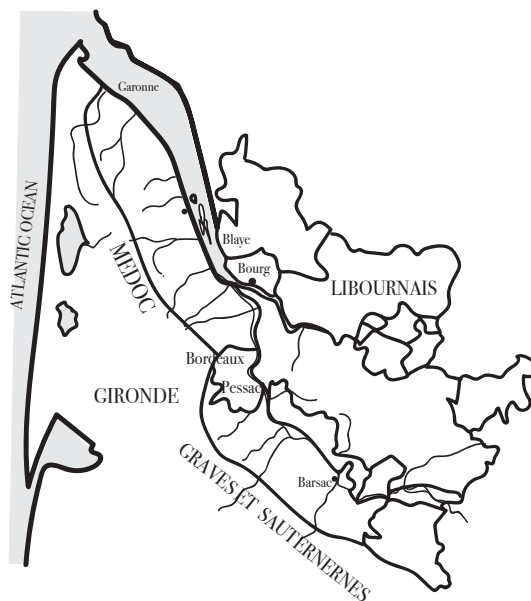

Bordeaux

The Bordeaux region is naturally divided by the Gironde Estuary into a Left Bank area which includes the Médoc and Graves and a Right Bank area which includes the Libournais, Bourg and Blaye. Both red and white Bordeaux wines are almost invariably blended. The permissible grape varieties in red Bordeaux are: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Petit Verdot. While wine making styles vary, a rule of thumb is that the Left Bank is predominantly Cabernet Sauvignon based with the Right Bank being more Merlot based. The Graves area produces both red wine (from the grapes previously mentioned) and white wine from the Sauvignon blanc, Sémillon and Muscadelle grapes. The area of Sauternes (including Barsac) is known for its botrytized dessert wines.

Gin & Vodka

Gin

The origins of these variants lie in a desire to mask the flavour of raw spirits by adding in aromatic herbs and spices. Juniper berries are what gives Gin its distinctive taste and are in fact so important that they are required by law to be the core botanical in any drink that wants to call itself Gin.

London Dry Gin

By law London Gin must be produced by redistilling the neutral spirit in a pot still in the presence of juniper and the other botanicals. No other flavours may be added after distillation.

Sloe gin is a red liqueur made with gin and sloe drupes, which are a small fruit relative of the plum. The traditional way of making sloe gin is to soak the sloes in gin and then add sugar to ensure the sloe juice is extracted from the fruit.

Vodka

Vodka is generally a water-white colourless spirit with a light flavour intensity. The historic heartland of Vodka was Poland and Russia but is now made throughout the world. By the end of the twentieth century, it had become one of the world's most popular spirits. The alcoholic wash used to make vodka can be made from any fermentable agricultural material although in practice grains and molasses are preferred options.

Rums

Sugar cane originated in Asia and by the fourteenth century merchants had imported it into Spain. The early Spanish explorers took sugar cane to the Caribbean where rum has been produced for over 400 years.

White Rum

White rums with a high percentage of column still spirit will generally be light in intensity, However, they will retain some character of the base material including grassiness, sugar cane and cinnamon.

Tequila

The Spanish Conquistadores brought the technology of distillation to Central America and produced the first distillate from agave. To be called Tequila the spirit must be made from the blue agave. Agave base distillate are made throughout Mexico and are known by the generic title of mezcal.

Whiskey

By far the most complex of the grain spirits is whisk(e)y, which was probably first distilled by Irish monks as early as the fifteenth century. Top quality whiskies are now made throughout the world. Note the spelling can vary depending on the country of origin.

The whiskey of international renown produced in the USA is Bourbon. Under Federal law at least 51 per cent of the grains used to make Bourbon must be corn. Tennessee Whiskey is produced in exactly the same way as Bourbon except that before maturation the spirit is slowly dripped through maple wood charcoal. In the United States, "rye whiskey" is, by law, made from a mash of at least 51 percent rye and aged in charred, new oak barrels.

Canadian Whiskey

Canada produces large volumes of soft easy drinking corn-based whisky. Distiller can also add up to 9.09 per cent of other beverage, which can give these whiskies a very typical taste.
